

PP&VA Art-form Subcommittees and Community Advisors

The Penrith Performing & Visual Arts Board of Management is advised by the following artform specific Subcommittees i.e.

- *Theatre and Dance Subcommittee*

To be responsible for overseeing PP&VA theatre and dance performance and education programs. Membership to include Board members plus five Community Advisors (including at least one specialist theatre and/or dance education community advisor).

- *Music and Conservatorium Subcommittee*

To be responsible for overseeing PP&VA music performance and education programs. Membership to include Board members plus five Community Advisors (including at least one specialist music performance community advisor and one specialist music education community advisor).

- *Visual Arts Subcommittee*

To be responsible for overseeing visual arts exhibition, Collection, education and public programs. Membership to include Board members five Community Advisors (including at least one specialist visual arts education community advisor).

PP&VA Subcommittees Roles and Responsibilities

Visual Arts Subcommittee:

To advise the PP&VA Board of Management on all aspects of PP&VA visual arts activities, including:

- Penrith Regional Gallery & The Lewers (PRG&LB) operations, policies and procedures
- PRG&LB exhibition and education programs
- Artwork acquisitions and Collection
- PRG&LB community engagement programs (including Friends of the PRG&LB)
- PP&VA strategic planning.

Theatre and Dance Subcommittee:

To advise the PP&VA Board of Management on all PP&VA theatre and dance performance and education programs, including:

- Q Theatre Company policies and programs, including annual subscription, production and education programs
- PP&VA dance and film presentation and education programs
- PP&VA performing arts community engagement programs and initiatives
- Community theatre and dance policies, programs, performances and events
- PP&VA strategic planning.

Music and Conservatorium Subcommittee:

To advise the PP&VA Board of Management on PP&VA music performance and education, including:

- Joan Sutherland Performing Arts Centre music programs, performances and events
- PP&VA music education policies, procedures and operations (including the Penrith Conservatorium of Music)
- Community music policies, programs and performances (including community-based orchestras, choirs, bands and ensembles)
- PP&VA strategic planning.

Community Advisor Membership, Selection Criteria and Meetings

- Each artform subcommittee to include five community advisors.
- Community advisors to be from the local (Penrith) and regional (Western Sydney) community.
- Community advisors to be selected by the Board on the basis of submitted Expressions of Interest outlining interest, commitment and experience in the development of cultural activity in Penrith and the surrounding region.
- Term of membership for community advisors to be three years, with the possibility of extension as approved by the Board.
- PP&VA Board artform subcommittees to meet on a bi-monthly basis in advance of each Board meeting
- The role of community advisors is advisory only.
